2010 **Boat Owners Advanced Training Team Application**

OWSA is presenting the opportunity to 3 to 4 OWSA members to share the use of the OWSA Ranger 20 "Stardust" for the 2010 sailing season. The boat will be in the water from approximately April 1 thru September 30.

Things to know and things to commit time to:

1. This opportunity is for intermediate or experienced sailors only.
2. You will each be paying \$35 per month toward expenses while using the boat.
3. You will need to learn to run and troubleshoot outboard engines.
4. Outboard fuel and oil will be paid by the team.
5. Stardust team obligations:
 - a. Be an active member of the Ranger 20 fleet.
 - b. Enter the boat in 2 non-owsa evening series and 2 weekend regattas during 2010.
 - c. Participate in all OWSA sailing events, including Wed. night sail.
6. Each team member is responsible for any damage incurred to the boat or another vessel , up to \$250. This may be covered on your homeowners or renters insurance policy, so check.
7. Applicants must have been an OWSA member prior to March 31st, 2009.

The lucky "Stardust" team will be announced at the OWSA May general meeting.

BOAT Team 2010 Letter of Application:

Indicate name, address, phone number and email at the top of the page.

The following should be answered yes or no:

1. Member of OWSA prior to March 31, 2009?
2. Willing to share the boat with two to three other members?
3. Will commit to participate in required activities?
4. Boat owner at this time?

Please address the following in essay form:

1. Describe past sailing experience, present sailing goals and how this experience would help you meet those goals.
2. Sailing includes the ability to successfully solve problems that occur out on the water. Explain how your skills will help with this challenge.
3. Describe your involvement with OWSA, including activities and volunteer roles.
4. Describe how you would share this experience with the OWSA membership.
5. The team will be responsible for the boat. Describe how you visualize working with a team to take care of the boat, including working with the BOAT Committee overseeing "Stardust."
